To account for all votes that impact spending, taxes and significant regulations, 10 points are counted for an "A" grade in the National Taxpayers Union rating of Congress, 5 points for a "B+" and 3 points for a "B". Four points were awarded if a representative did NOT sponsor HR 2378 or HR 3012, two bills that could have triggered a trade war if adopted. Three points were awarded to representatives who scored a 100% in the Club's RePork card on earmark votes in 2009, 2 points for scores of 95% to 99% and 1 point for scores from 90% to 94%. Representatives who sponsored HR 1321, a big government health care bill, have 5 points deducted from their totals if they voted against ObamaCare.
