A recent poll of likely Republican primary voters in Alabama conducted by WPA Intelligence on behalf of Club for Growth PAC shows that Tommy Tuberville and Jeff Sessions are leading the race with Bradley Byrne a distant third.

If the election were held today, Tommy Tuberville and Jeff Sessions would advance to a run-off.

Tommy Tuberville now leads the field with 32% of the vote, up three points since last week. Jeff Sessions is in second with 29%, down five in the last week. Bradley Byrne is in third place, 12 points behind Sessions and has made no gains in the last week.

Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 607 likely Republican primary voters in Alabama. Interviews were conducted using live telephone interviews to cell phones (43% of interviews) and interactive voice response (IVR) calls to landlines from February 18-19, 2020. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 4.0\%$. Sample was selected from the Alabama voter file with the probability of selection being equal to the probability of voting in the March Republican primary election in WPAi's turnout model. Sample was stratified by age, gender, and geography to ensure accurate representation of the electorate.
