SENATE AND JOE LOMBARDO LEADING THE PRIMARY FOR GOVERNOR

A WPA Intelligence poll of Nevada Republican Primary Voters conducted on behalf of Club for Growth PAC March 13 - 15, 2022, shows Adam Laxalt with a large lead in the Republican primary for U.S. Senate while Joe Lombardo leads the primary for Governor, followed by Dean Heller and John Lee.

## Adam Laxalt leads the primary for U.S. Senate by 38 points.

- Laxalt leads with 57% of the vote.
- Sam Brown trails substantially at just 19% and the other two candidates receive one percent each.
- Three percent say they would vote for someone else or none of the candidates and 15% are undecided.

## In the Governor primary, Lombardo leads by six over Dean Heller.

- Lombardo leads with 28% of the vote, six points ahead of Heller.
- John Lee receives 13% of the vote and Joey Gilbert is at 9%.
- Three other candidates, including Michele Fiori who withdrew from the race after this poll was conducted, are in the low single-digits.

## Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 500 likely Republican primary voters in Nevada. Data was collected by live telephone interviews from March 13-15, 2022. Fifty-five percent (55%) of the interviews were conducted to cell phones with the remaining 45% to landlines. A random sample was selected from the Nevada voter file and was stratified by geography, age, gender, and vote history to ensure a representative sample. The survey has a margin of error of  $\pm 4.4\%$  at the 95% confidence level.
